River Dell 2023 AP Exam Testing Policies

Testing Arrival and Exam Rooms

- Students taking morning exams must arrive to the testing room no later than 7:15 AM.
- Students taking afternoon exams must arrive to the testing room no later than 11:15 AM
- Students will not be allowed to take the exam if they are tardy.
- AP Japanese will take place in Library classroom 105A. AP Spanish will take place in Lower Gym.
- Extra time will be in room 809 or 811 unless otherwise communicated to students.
- All other exams will be in the lower gym (Statistics will be in both gyms). Students with extra time will test in either room 809 or 811.
- The College Board strongly discourages students from being absent. Makeup exams are permitted only if a student is too ill to come into the building (doctor's note required).

Materials Permitted in Exam Rooms

- Students should bring at least two, sharpened #2 pencils with erasers (mechanical pencils are not allowed) and two pens with black or dark blue ink.
- Graphing calculators are required for the Calculus, Chemistry, Statistics and Physics exams.
 *Biology students may use a four function (with square root) calculator, a scientific or a graphing calculator.
 Bring extra batteries for your calculator. Visit apstudent.collegeboard.org/apcourse for specific calculator policies.
- Students taking AP Physics must bring a ruler or straight edge.
- Students should bring a watch in case they can't see the clock in the exam room. An Apple or any other digital watch is not permitted. See guidelines in AP Terms and Conditions.
- For AP Spanish and Japanese only: your charged RD laptop and headset (for the speaking section of the exam).
- Students are encouraged to bring an extra sweater/sweatshirt in case the testing rooms are chilly.

What is Not Permitted in the Exam Rooms

- NO CELL PHONES, SMART WATCHES OR ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE ALLOWED AT THE <u>TESTING SITE!!</u> If a student uses a cell phone or unauthorized electronic device, the student's score will be cancelled, and no retest will be permitted.
- <u>Students may not bring food or drink to an exam</u> unless they have a documented medical condition that requires that they eat a snack or have drink. This it outlined in the AP Terms and Conditions.
- Students may eat before exams or during breaks outside the testing room.

Other Information

- Students must park in their assigned high school parking spot.
- Students should take the exam seriously and do their best.
- Students will remain seated until all have completed the exam. No one may leave the exam early.
- Students taking PM exams may not be able to finish in time for after school activities.
- If a student has both a morning and an afternoon exam during the same day, the student should pack a lunch. There will not be enough time to go out and eat. Students will be able to eat lunch in a designated space outside of the exam room.
- Students <u>must</u> bring a note to or have a parent contact Ms. Ioele a day prior to an exam if their parent gives them permission to miss morning classes before an afternoon exam *or* to miss afternoon classes after a morning exam.
