- Unweighted academic average of B or better (3.0 on 4.0 scale)
- Graduating high school senior who intends to enroll next semester in an accredited college or university
- Pursuing a major in business, one of the physical sciences, technology, engineering, arts, or mathematics field
- Underrepresented People of Color

Additionally, the AABE NJ Chapter offers a discretionary scholarship for applicants who are immediate family members of NJ Chapter members. The amount of this scholarship will be determined based on the applicant's qualifications.
