

Alfredo F. Gioffre Italian-American Memorial Scholarship Requirements

Award Requirements:

This application consists of four parts: academics, athletics, community service and Italian heritage.

Essay:

Italian Heritage: In short essay form (2-3 paragraphs), describe what your Italian heritage means to you and how it has affected your life. Must be Italian or of Italian-American heritage. The genealogy should be traced back to both Parents, one Parent, both Grandparents or one Grandparent. Provide the name of the region and town/village from where your family comes from in Italy.

Academics: The chairperson will take into consideration your high school grades ("B" Student or better). In addition, briefly describe any scholastic honors or awards you have earned during your high school years. Include in this part of the application any academic information that you believe sets you apart. Must be attending a college after graduation.

Athletics: List the sports in which you have participated during your high school years. Be sure to include the year played (9th, 10th, 11th, 12th), position played, leadership position on the team and all honors and distinctions earned.

Resume:

Community Service: Describe all community service activities in which you have been involved with and your involvement during your high school years.

Optional: Teacher, counselor and/or coach recommendation letters.

Other "Plusses"

Should also be active in other non-athletic extracurricular activities.

On and off the field - good character, possess leadership qualities, respect towards teammates/coaches/teachers/administrators, positive spirit, encourage others, help others and have a never-die attitude
